Through a programme of continual improvement to the environmental management system to enhance environmental performance, we will demonstrate our commitment to:

- Complying fully with relevant environmental legislation.
- Optimising efficient use of raw materials and non-renewable resources.
- Improving efficiency of operations
- Minimising production of wastes at source
- Improving energy usage and energy reduction
- Specifying and using products which minimise their environmental impacts in production, use and disposal
- Providing all employees with an understanding of this environmental policy, and their responsibilities in controlling and improving environmental performance.

In the event of an environmental accident or incident at work, it is a company requirement that the details are promptly and properly reported to the Management, who will investigate and take prompt action to make good and avoid recurrence.

All contractors working on behalf of Impress Group are required to adopt environmental standards fully consistent with those of the Company and they are expected to achieve comparable levels of performance as a condition of their contract

The management team of Impress Group, who take prime responsibility for the delivery of its aspirations, have also reviewed this Environment Policy and will review periodically to ensure that it remains relevant and appropriate to the organisation. In doing so will develop suitable objectives, targets and management programmes, applying appropriate operational procedures to minimise our significant environmental impacts during normal, abnormal and emergency conditions.
